GOVERNMENT NOTICE

Ontario Regulation 666/98 (Possession, Buying and Selling of Wildlife)
made under the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act, 1997

Upon the authority of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act and in accordance with Ontario Regulation 666/98, the royalties for transporting a furbearing mammal or its pelt outside Ontario are set as follows. The amounts are rounded to the nearest \$0.05.
