Letter of Consent - Secondary Trapping Licence (Youth)

A trapping licence may be issued to an applicant who is between 12 and 15 years of age, if the applicant files, with the application, a *Letter of Consent* (Ontario Regulation 667/98 (Trapping), *Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act, 1997*). The *Letter of Consent* must be signed by a parent with whom the applicant resides, or if the applicant does not reside with a parent, by a guardian. The *Letter of Consent* must be signed and submitted annually along with an *Ontario Trapping Licence – Application for Renewal to obtain a Secondary Trapping Licence (Youth)*. Youth trappers are required to submit a *Mandatory Season-End Harvest Report* by June 10 of each licence year to indicate the quantity of fur harvested, sold, and kept in possession.
